November and December 2020

We thank God for helping us get here, and accomplish the work that has been commanded to us on this region of Colombia, it was a great time and we've seen the power of God working on our favor and on favor of His Work, is awesome to see how God goes on front of us getting the way ready in the middle of all the obstacles and difficulties.

Ministerial Blessings

November:

We give the Glory to God for having helped us to accomplish the purpose of finishing the complete training of the missionaries during the pandemic on 2020, the five students that came into the Missions School of the Amazonas, finished their cross cultural missionary training with pastoral emphasis; on their final practicum God supported their preaching, visits and the rest of the tasks they had on their practicum place, the pastors and the people saw God working on their lives during this awesome time.

Also, we finally had a graduation, it was a beautiful time where God confirmed their callings in His big work on the Hearth; we thank God and every brother and sister that trusted in us for this task. Now, we pray for every graduated missionary to follow the way that God has traced for the missionary calling.

December:

Once finished the missionary training, we started another area of our ministry that God has given to us and is to strengthen the white missional fields, places where the missionary support and work is less, with the purpose of promote, motivate and train the brothers and sisters that are on those fields over the rivers Amazonas, Atacuari, Loreto Yaco, Putumayo, Mirití and Güacayá on the Amazonas state and the Peruvian Communities around these; where we've found indigenous people that are ready to be trained on the missionary work and many couples of youth and adults that have told us their great desire to be taught on the Word of The Lord and on How to take the Gospel to other cultures and communities of far away.

We visited some of them that are over the Amazonas River:

1. San Juan Community (Over the Atacuari River – Colombia)
2. Puerto Rico Community (Over the Loreto Yaco River – Colombia)
3. Macedonia Community (Over the Amazonas River – Colombia)
4. Zaragoza Community (Over the Amazonas River – Colombia)
5. Santa Cecilia Community (Is a Ticuna Indigenous Community placed over a creek that goes to the Amazonas River – Perú)
6. Caballo Cocha (Small town of Perú)

In all of them are leaders and pastors that are doing the work for The Lord, but they are requesting for support on contextualized theological training and also, we motivated them so in 2022 they can be candidates to be trained as cross-cultural missionaries and do the missionary work where there is no gospel.

Another fundamental reason for our visit was to motivate and be close to our graduates of the Missions School to know about their ministerial status, we visited many of them and were able to give counseling to some others too, also we continued motivating them to be faithful to The Lord and in the ministry, we involved some of them on this missionary word, which we will be doing on 2021.

Ministerial Opposition:

Thanks to God we didn't have any opposition on this trip, however, there was one that we had and was to not have enough time and more hands and not to be able to be multiplied in order to do this work more frequently, because of the costs, the distance and the number of places that need support and that have not been reached for the gospel yet.

Familiar Blessings:

We thank God that has keep our family of all bad and danger on this 2020 and God has been faithful until the end, we praise God because little by little we are getting used to the house that God has given to us and with the poultry that God has used to help us with a part of our income, glory be to God that has been faithful.

During the 2020 on December my wife and I had our 15th anniversary and we praise God because have been our best years on life, to be together serving God as missionaries among a generation of people that wants to know The Lord in the middle of cultures different to ours; also, God has given both of us the same passion and fire to take the gospel there, and train others to accomplish the Great Commission. Just went we moved to our house, on the 9th Km on the way to Tarapacá, our son Samuel had an asthmatic attack, but we praise God because he is now fine and protected by God of any other attack from the evil one.

Personal Blessings:

My wife and I feel happy to be able to plan to do our ministry with more freedom on this 2021, to be able to bring accompaniment to our graduates on their ministries, mentor them, minister to them; also, to train those that are to go to take the gospel to the less reached places, and support on missionary training to churches of the river that long to know ow to do missionary work in a cross-cultural environment and finally to strengthen the leadership of the communities on different spiritual areas.

Personal Opposition:

We cry out to God so we can travel with freedom, and for any attack from the devil to be destroyed on the name of Jesus, we believe that is possible to face opposition, but God will give us the victory on all circumstances that we face.

PROYECTIONS FOR THE 2021:

1. To train interested couples at 4 communities, on learning more from the Lord to serve Him on short term in the ministry.
2. Support the graduates with counsellorship and missionary ministry on the river.
3. To promote the Missions School of the Amazonas for 2022 and to encourage others to keep learning.
4. To continue supporting the training at Tarapacá (twice a year) and Mirití (once a year).
5. To continue the outreach at the community of Citacoyd, every 8 days with one of our graduates.

We want to thank you all for being a part of our ministry and that God has placed us to get together where the accomplishment of the Great Commission is still pending. We encourage you to keep praying for us and if you are blessing us in any way please don't stop doing it because there still a lot to do and the task is not finished yet. God bless you greatly.
